

Ms. Rembert is the Director of Ceres' Investor Initiative for Sustainable Exchanges, where she leads a coalition of investors focused on engagement with stock exchanges to improve ESG (Environmental, Social and Governance) reporting across markets. She also serves as the Senior Manager for Investor Engagement at Ceres--working closely with institutional investors to improve their investment practices on climate and sustainability issues, and to help investors better promote ESG practices at global corporations through shareholder engagement, regulatory advocacy, and strategic joint initiatives.

Before joining Ceres, she served as the Senior Corporate Governance Analyst and Coordinator of Corporate Engagement at the Service Employees International Union, as the Governance and Engagement Officer at Pax World Funds, and she led the Shareholder Action Network (a national clearinghouse for shareholder activism on sustainability issues) in the US for five years while at US SIF. Before her 15-year career in responsible investment and engagement, she was an environmental journalist.

She is one of the first recipients of the Rising Stars of Corporate Governance Award from the Yale School of Management's Millstein Center for Corporate Governance and Performance (2008).
