GK - Trading in Shares

<u>TCL & CCC – CEMEX announces Change and variation to Take-Over Bid</u>

• Trinidad Cement Limited (TCL) & Caribbean Cement Company Limited (CCC) have advised that CEMEX has announced by way of release on January 10, 2017 that its indirect subsidiary, Sierra Trading (SIERRA), will present a change and variation notice making an amended offer to the offer and take-over bid that was presented on December 5, 2016 to all shareholders of TCL, to acquire up to 132,616,942 ordinary shares in TCL, at a revised price of TT\$5.07 in cash per TCL shares, which together with Sierra's existing share ownership in TCL of approximately 39.5%, would, if successful, result in Sierra holding up to 74.9% of the equity share capital in TCL.
