#### **GK – Potential Merger of Affiliate**

The GraceKennedy Group has a 40% interest in Signia Financial Group which is based in Barbados. GK further advised that the non-binding Letter of Intent was signed in November 2017 and is the basis of exploratory discussions on the feasibility of a merger of the two entities.
