

# Eppley, Fortress and Altman Complete Agreement

**Eppley Fund Managers Limited ("Eppley"), Fortress Fund Managers Limited ("Fortress") and Altman Real Estate ("Altman")** have completed their agreement signed in January 2018, pursuant to which Eppley has now assumed all investment management and advisory responsibilities for the **Fortress Caribbean Property Fund Limited SCC**. Following a special shareholders' meeting held in February, the Fund is now expected to be renamed the **Eppley Caribbean Property Fund Limited SCC**.

Eppley's Managing Director, Nicholas Scott, who was in Barbados to conclude the transition said, "We are pleased that the transaction is now final and we look forward to implementing our plans to create value for shareholders." He indicated that Eppley intends to share its immediate and long-term plans for the Fund with shareholders in the near future.

Managing Director of Fortress, Roger Cave, said the agreement received the full support of the Fund's Board, noting, "We are delighted to have found an organisation of Eppley's calibre to take over management of the Fund. At Fortress, we still believe strongly in real estate as an asset class, particularly for long-term investors like pension funds, and we expect to continue as major investors in the Fund." Mr. Cave will serve as a non-executive director on the Fund's Board. He said this change will enable Fortress to focus exclusively on growing its core Caribbean and global fund management business.

Altman will continue to support the Fund, providing property management, accounting and other administrative services. "We are happy to know that the shareholders in the Fund will be under the guidance of the Eppley team," said Sir Paul Altman, Managing Director of Altman. "They have achieved success in a variety of businesses and we would expect a similar level of success to be achieved with the Property Fund."

**Eppley Limited** is a listed investment company that originates and invests primarily in credit opportunities in Jamaica, the Caribbean and Central America for its own account and on behalf of its investors. Eppley Limited also owns and operates commercial real estate in Jamaica alongside its joint venture partners.
